### What students do:

Students visiting Waradah Centre will learn about Aboriginal Heritage in a series of three activities.

- In a private room, students engage in an interactive talk on traditional Aboriginal culture looking at how Aboriginal people lived in a sustainable way in a natural environment for thousands of years.
- In a private room, explanations of traditional painting techniques and symbols used in Aboriginal desert art are given.
- Background to the Desert Painting movement is explained.
- Individual boomerang decorating and painting workshop under guidance. Students are then able to keep their boomerang.
- In the Performance Theatre, starting with the traditional Smoking Ceremony, experience Australia's colourful history from our Indigenous heritage to our modern day multicultural society in full period costumes and delivered on stage to backdrops recreated on 3 large screens. Other features of the show include the Dreaming Stories of the 'Didgeridoo' and the 'Seven Sisters'.
