Please make sure that your student to teacher ratio has been considered. While your students are in the Centre, Waradah staff will take appropriate care to oversee them and meet their needs so that all can experience an enjoyable and educational activity. However we do ask that teachers continue to take an active role in supervising their students while in the centre and including the toilet areas.

There is a beautiful park with tables, chairs and toilet facilities next to the centre.

Teachers need to be aware that some students may find the sound of the didgeridoo too loud and intense or the dance performance slightly threatening. This would be an unusual reaction as the greater majority of children love it, but it can happen and there is a very low risk of the intensity of sound bringing on a seizure in epileptics. The intensity of sound needs to be discussed with students prior to attending so that they know what to expect.
